

## **Chicago Teacher Salaries in the Regional Chicago Context**

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## 1. How do salaries for Chicago Public School teachers stack up with other comparable fields in the Chicago area?

The following table summarizes annual salaries in the greater Chicago region by the Bureau of Labor Statistics. While annual incomes are comparable, teachers' weekly wages are substantially higher because teachers work so many fewer weeks in each 12-month period. For their salary, Chicago teachers are scheduled to work 177 days a year, amounting to 35.4 weeks. The contract is written for 208 days but includes 10 vacation days, 8 holidays, 10 sick days, and 3 personal days

The following table provides summary data on all workers and households in the City of Chicago, as reported by the Census Bureau for 2006-2010. Teacher salaries are for the current school year.
